Landing a good internship is much easier when you've completed various pre-internship opportunities. While internships may be available to students in their early years, they are more common for those in their penultimate and final years. Internships can be at big firms or smaller corporations and:

- **Part-time vs. full-time**
- **Summer-only vs. six months (or other durations)**
- **In-person vs. remote**

This will depend on your availability, academic requirements, the job market, and the specific needs of the sector or company at the time.



Securing a full-time role after graduation will largely depend on what you've accomplished during your bachelor's studies (pre-internships, internships, complementary courses, on-campus activities, corporate events, electives, etc.) and how relevant those experiences are to the field you're now applying to.
